

# FALL IN LOVE BASKET

The Fall in Love Basket is a sweet, simple, and fun to make project. In this mini class, you will fall in love with piecing all over again as you learn tried and true cutting and sewing techniques for precise piecing. You'll learn how to use glue-basting for accurate points & intersecting seams, and how to nest and spin your seams to reduce bulk, giving your block a beautiful finish. You'll leave class with skills to last a lifetime!



Measures: 10" x 3.5" x 7"

## SUPPLIES:

- Fall in Love Basket Pattern
- 1 - 18" x 24" cut of Annie's Soft and Stable (or your preferred stabilizer for making baskets)
- 1 FE each of 4 colors (I used: Ombre Bloom in Honey, Mustard, Tangerine, and Cayenne)
- 1/3 yd - Lining Fabric (Ombre Bloom Cherry)
- 1 FQ - Background Fabric (Bella Solids Off White)
- 1 - MicroFine Glue Tip
- 1 - 4oz Bottle of Elmer's Washable School Glue

## ALSO NEEDED:

- Spray Starch (Faultless is my favorite)
- Iron and Pressing Board
- Rotary Cutter, Rulers, and Mat
- Wonder Clips
- Neutral Thread - 50 wt Cotton
- Thread of choice for Quilting
- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Fabric Marking Pen/Pencil
- Basic Sewing Supplies



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
